SCHOOL OF LAW:

USP's School of Law is a dynamic team of teachers and legal scholars who have been providing legal education to current and future leaders in the legal professions, governments and the communities of the Pacific Islands region for more than a decade. The School of Law has been a pioneer in online legal education and delivers its courses online in more than a dozen Pacific Island countries. Through our research, consultancies and community outreach, we also seek to make a genuine contribution to knowledge and skills that underpin the administration of law and justice in the region. The School is seeking to make up to five academic appointments to enhance its operations at the Emalus Campus in Port Vila, Vanuatu, and at the Laucala Campus in Suva, Fiji. The successful candidates will join an inspiring group of teachers and researchers, who are leaders in their fields.

The appointments will be made to strengthen the five core legal areas of the Law School: Law and Governance; Land and Customary Law; Environmental Law; Tourism, Hospitality and Commerce; and Legal Education and Professional Skills. Without limiting areas of interest, current priorities include: environmental law, corporate and commercial law, tourism law, public law, civil procedure, legal skills and advocacy. The positions range from assistant lecturer to associate professor, according to qualifications, skills and experience as follows:

- A senior academic in the field of environmental law to oversee the introduction of a new Masters in Environmental Law program and develop the School's profile in this field at regional and international levels.
- A manager for USP's Community Legal Centre in Port Vila to coordinate the delivery of free legal services in civil matters to the Vanuatu community.
- A coordinator and instructor, appointed on a fractional basis, for the School's vocational courses in civil law and criminal law, leading to the award of a Certificate.
- Two general academic positions, one of which will be based at the Laucala Campus, Suva, Fiji.
