- Abstracts and papers must be written in English, complete with title, author's name, and institutional affiliation.
- Abstracts should contain the aim of the paper, essential results and a brief conclusion, (400 words, maximum).
- Please include 3-5 keywords, separated by commas.
- Abstracts should not contain tables, graphs, drawings, etc.
- Abstract should be submitted to: iucn.abstract@atmajaya.ac.id
- Abstracts will be reviewed on a rolling basis, as received, with a final deadline of **Friday, April 17, 2015**.
- The Academy will publish an edited and peer-reviewed collection of papers following the colloquium.
