SDGs and Environmental Law: Achievements and Challenges after a decade of creation

The Law School of the Universidad Científica del Sur (Científica) is proud to host the 22nd Annual Colloquium of the IUCN Academy of Environmental Law on 1 - 4 July 2025, **Lima Peru**.

We invite abstract submissions for papers presentation at the Colloquium by **12 February 2025**.

The theme of the 22nd Colloquium is **SDGs and Environmental Law: Achievements and Challenges after a Decade of Creation**. Coming on a decade since the creation of the SDGs, it is critical to assess how these goals have influenced legal policies and practices worldwide, identify the achievements made, and recognize persistent challenges that require urgent attention. This evaluation is essential to redirect efforts, adapt strategies, and strengthen the international legal framework to pursue a more sustainable and just future.

Exclusively two groups will be addressed within the group of SGDs, this is due to their critical relevance in the context of environmental law and their ability to address these central concerns. These blocks encapsulate the essential elements of sustainable development:

Group 1: Environmental Sustainability and Climate Action

- SDG 13 (Climate Action): Analysis of national and international legislation focused on mitigating climate change and adapting to its effects.
- SDG 14 (Life below water): Review of policies and laws that promote the conservation and sustainable use of oceans, seas and marine resources.
- SDG 15 (Life on Terrestrial Ecosystems): Discussion on legal strategies to protect, restore and promote the sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and halt and reverse land degradation and halt . the loss of biodiversity.

Group 2: Prosperity and Sustainability Use of Resources

- SDG 6 (Clean water and sanitation): Assessment of regulations that ensure the availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all.
- SDG 7 (Affordable and non-polluting energy): Analysis of energy policies and their link to sustainable development.
- SDG 12 (Responsible production and consumption): Discussion on legal initiatives that promote sustainable consumption and production patterns.

We welcome submissions on the broad theme of the Colloquium, as well as on any other topics relevant to environmental law.

Guidelines for abstracts

- Abstracts must be sent in English, with title author(s) name(s), and institutional affiliation.
- Abstracts should be 300 words maximum.
- Abstracts should contain the aim of the paper, main points, and a brief conclusion. (Abstracts should not contain tables, graphs, drawings, etc).
